It is your responsibility to provide and maintain a valid email address to receive your electronic account statement. If your e-mail address changes, it is your responsibility to submit a change of address to the Credit Union.

You must have a valid internet e-mail address, access to the internet and a printer to take full advantage of this offering.

Your browser must have cookies enabled and the latest version of the free Adobe Reader to view and print. Depending on your statement closing date, you may receive one more paper statement.

We reserve the right to cancel this service, change the terms of your use of this service or send disclosures in paper form at any time.

We make every effort to ensure that this service is provided without interruption; however, we are not responsible for any delay or failure on our part in sending you e-mail reminders or in making this website or paperless statements available to you.
