Chung Bothwell is currently Chairman of the Board of Directors for UNCLE Credit Union in Livermore. This is her fourteen years serving as UNCLE Board Chairman. She has served as a Board Director for UNCLE in varied capacity from Treasurer to Chairman for over 30 years with UNCLE organization.
