

Candidate Statement: Robin Morris

I have recently retired from the City of Livermore after 35 years of service, retiring as the Police Business Services Manager. During my career, I developed and oversaw the police department's \$45 million budget, performed financial analysis and budgetary management, and created internal control procedures to ensure compliance with budget allocations. I conducted financial forecasting by providing revenue and expenditure projections and assisted in the preparation and monitoring of Police Department grants. I served as a trustee and member of the City's Deferred Compensation Committee for 10 years. I was a member of the East County Animal Shelter Committee for 18 years, serving as Chairperson for the last 10 years.

Prior to joining the Police Department, I held the position of Accountant in the Finance department, where I was responsible for developing the City's personnel budget and overseeing payroll processing and compliance functions.

I served as a member of the UNCLE Supervisory Committee for 7 years and currently serve as a member of the Board of Directors. I have served on the Audit Committee for five years and was Chairperson of the committee for two years.

I received my Bachelor of Science Degree in Business Management from the University of Phoenix and have been a certified tax preparer for more than 30 years.

Wishing to give back to the community, I have volunteered my time spending 8 years on the adult advisory board, working with Livermore's Masonic Youth Group Rainbow for Girls, serving as Treasurer and Vice Chairman. I spent two years as President of the parent support group for the Liberty High School choir program and spent 12 years serving as Treasurer of the Livermore Management Group.
